January

Thank God It's Over (5.0 abv)

Chocolate orange stout brewed especially for the bah-humbugs of this world. Brewed with a light bitterness it gives way to a smooth chocolatey body with a hint of orange. A beer to smooth away even the harshest credit card bill.

January/February

Aquarian Ale (4.0 abv)

This amber ale brewed to reflect the unique qualities of this most inventive sign of the zodiac is complimented by the use of crystal rye malt. This extenuates the reddish hue present with the grist and together with a prominent bitter finish makes for a Moorish tasting beer.

February/March

Suitably Irish (5.6 abv)

This powerful Irish bitter stout is smooth and very easy to drink for its gravity. Full black bodied with a creamy white head makes an attractive but deceptively strong pint.

March/April

Harry Jacks (4.1 abv)

Delta Dark (4.8 abv)

Brewed for mild May, this is a meaty mild with a great body. One to be savoured slowly.

May/June/July

Summers Pearl (4.0 abv)

Light golden in colour, this is an excellent Summer session ale.

June/July

Murphys Law (4.5 abv)

Not too bitter and light enough for the long summer days. A noticeable taste of strawberries is complimented by a thick creamy white head. Stockport born and bred.

July/August

Scholars Prayer (4.3 abv)

This beer is guaranteed to finish top of the class. An amber coloured ale, it has a marked bitterness with a degree of long lasting satisfaction for the palette.

August/September

Fathers Favourite (4.2 abv)

A full bodied ale for its gravity. This light amber coloured beer contains hints of coffee and caramel in the taste. Complimented by a spicy hop character and a prominent aroma.

September/October

Julies Pride (5.0 abv)

A full bodied and buxom ale that is bound to tickle your fancy. The stunning fruit and mouth feel underlines a sensuous bitterness.

November

Old Smokey (4.8 abv)
